Sample Letter

I am greatly concerned about the Kinder-Morgan Northeast Energy Direct (NED) pipeline project, specifically the proposed compressor station on Clarks Chapel Road in Nassau, New York. I see no positive benefits that this proposed project will deliver to New Yorkers; only risks to our health, safety and economic well-being.

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) scoping period is coming to a close on August 31, 2015. Kinder-Morgan has recently submitted a 6,500 page resource report update. It is impracticable to think that the public or elected officials can adequately review this document within FERC's current given time frame.

A cursory review of the report reveals that there are still thousands of pieces of information listed as to-be-determined, numerous sections with critical information that is being inappropriately withheld as proprietary; and many incomplete, inaccurate or blatantly false statements of information provided to FERC by Kinder-Morgan's consultants. Kinder-Morgan has indicated to FERC that they will further supplement this report before the end of October. It seems that FERC affords Kinder-Morgan repeated opportunities to supplement and amend their project proposal yet continues to hold fast to an arbitrary deadline date for public input on the project of August 31<sup>st</sup>.

I am asking that you doing everything you can possibly do to get FERC to extend the August 31<sup>st</sup> date for scoping until at least November 30, 2015.
