Sample Letter

I am greatly concerned about the Kinder-Morgan Northeast Energy Direct (NED) pipeline project. I see no positive benefits that this proposed project will deliver to New Yorkers; only risks to our health, safety and economic well-being.

Both the Rensselaer and Schoharie County Legislatures have recently passed resolutions calling on you to place a moratorium on the issuance of all State permits associated with the Kinder-Morgan NED pipeline project until the Commissioner of Health completes a human health impact study of gas pipeline infrastructure and makes recommendations to you.

I ask that you direct the Commissioner of Health to undertake such a study so that the health and well being of all the New Yorkers who reside along and near the ever increasing web of pipelines, compressor station and other pipeline infrastructure are afforded the health and safety protection that we deserve and you sought to provide when you banned the practice of hydro-fracking in NYS. I also ask that you direct the Commissioners of the Department of Environmental Conservation and the Department of State to withhold the review and issuance of permits that the NED may require until such time as the Health Commissioner has completed his review and issued his findings report and recommendations.
